- Alpha letters & numbers.
- Textures.
- Lots of different photos.
- Just portions of photos, zoom in, get up close and personal!
- Lots of papers in different colors, themes, and textures.
- Elements galore! Try applying the filter to portions of an element by first drawing a selection around the part of the element you want, and then pressing Ctrl J (Mac: Cmd J).
