



Post-Flop Considerations

- Playing post-flop as the pre-flop caller is much different than as the pre-flop aggressor because we'll rarely have the initiative and we'll also have a capped range.

Capped Range: A pre-flop range of starting hands that has a ceiling to it, which typically doesn't include exceptionally strong starting hands.

- So, our post-flop considerations will include different factors.
