Throwglobe Tumbler Supply List To

Hello! Below is a list of the supplies I use to make my snowglobe tumblers – with a vegetable glycerin and water liquid mixture. I've included links to the items I purchase and use but you are more than welcome to shop around and choose alternatives.

Everything I've linked is something I regularly use to make my snowglobe tumblers. I would not recommend anything that I did not love or trust. However, please keep in mind that everyone has their own preferences and experiences with a product.

- Double Wall Acrylic Tumblers (I use a mix of the ones below)
 - Maars Acrylic Tumblers (I recommend only the 24 oz size in this brand)
 - Krafty Cups 4 U double wall tumblers (I recommend for the 16 oz size)
 - Starbucks Acrylic Tumblers found in Starbucks stores
- Raw+Rare Vegetable Glycerin: 32 oz bottle or 1 gallon bottle
- Purified or distilled water I use Kirkland brand drinking water from Costco
- Condiment squeeze bottles
- Glitter (preferably chunky or chunky mixes)
 - My favorite glitters are from <u>cieloylunadesigns.com</u>
 - I also like Recollection chunky glitter mixes from Michael's
 - I recommend looking for small businesses on IG to shop for glitter
- Hot-fix rhinestone applicator tool with the 34ss (or 7mm) concave tip
- <u>UV lamp with clamp</u>
- UV Resin
- <u>Cabinet door bumpers</u> (12.7mm width x 3.5mm height)
 - Some crafters use glue dots, hot glue sticks, or gorilla tape but these door bumpers have worked the best for me in avoiding leaks
- Weeding tool
- Rubbing alcohol
- Popsicle sticks or other type of mixing sticks
- Paper towels

The items below are not necessary but optional and helpful:

- <u>Disposable gloves</u>
- Spray bottle for rubbing alcohol
- Silicone cups and mixing sticks
