LESSON PLANS

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this lesson is for the kids to start using phrases to express what they want or not want. Please look up and translate any items or actions that they are usually saying they want or not want so they can practice with this verb. There is room on the Speaking Card for words to be added. Remember to practice first yourself before introducing to kids. It ALWAYS helps.

TIMELINE

The same as other lessons. The kids will probably pick this up faster than you think, because there is always an interest to let you know what they want. But these are the first phrases to remember so give them as much time as they need to remember these.
