- Activation Exercises to help you walk in your calling.

Week 1: The Callings of God in the New Testament

Key Scripture

2 Timothy 1:9 (NKJV) – "who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began."

Main Teaching

- We are first called to Christ before we are called to do anything.
- Our calling includes salvation, holiness, and fellowship with God.
- God has placed a specific role and purpose for each believer within the body of Christ.

Reflection Questions

- 1. How has your understanding of calling changed after this lesson?
- What part of your calling have you been resisting or unsure about?
- 3. How can you begin to walk in your calling today?

Activation Exercise

 Write down three ways you can respond to your calling this week.

 Spend time in prayer, asking the Holy Spirit to give you clarity about your calling.

Week 2: What We Are Called to Be

Key Scripture

Romans 8:29 (NKJV) – "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son."

Main Teaching

- We are called to be Sons of God, Kings, and Priests.
- Jesus walked as Prophet, Priest, and King, and we share in His anointing.
- Our calling is about identity before function.

Reflection Questions

- 1. Do you see yourself as a son/daughter of God? Why or why not?
- 2. How can you walk in your kingly and priestly identity?
- 3. How does understanding your identity affect your spiritual gifts?

Activation Exercise

 Declare daily, "I am a son/daughter of God, called to reign as a king and minister as a priest." Find one way this week to operate as a priest (minister to God) and as a king (walk in authority).

Week 3: The Gifts of God (Romans 12)

Key Scripture

Romans 12:6 (NKJV) – "Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them."

Main Teaching

- The Grace Gifts (Motivational Gifts) include:
 - 1. **Prophecy** (Declaring Truth)
 - 2. Serving (Meeting Needs)
 - **3. Teaching** (Communicating Truth)
 - **4. Exhortation** (Encouraging Others)
 - 5. **Giving** (Providing Resources)
 - Leading (Organizing & Directing)
 - 7. Mercy (Compassion & Healing)

Reflection Questions

- 1. Which of these gifts resonate most with you?
- 2. How can you use your grace gift to serve others?
- 3. How can you develop and grow in your gift?

Activation Exercise

 Identify one gift you believe you have and start using it this week.

 Pray for an opportunity to exercise this gift in serving others.

Week 4: The Ministry Gifts of Christ (Ephesians 4)

Key Scripture

Ephesians 4:11-12 (NKJV) – "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry."

Main Teaching

- The Fivefold Ministry Gifts equip believers for maturity and effectiveness:
 - 1. Apostles (Builders & Fathers)
 - 2. **Prophets** (Voice & Watchmen)
 - 3. Evangelists (Soul-Winners)
 - **4. Pastors** (Shepherds & Nurturers)
 - **5. Teachers** (Instructors of Truth)

Reflection Questions

1. Which ministry gifts have you benefited from most in your life?

2. Which ministry gift do you feel drawn toward?

3. How can you honor and receive from all fivefold gifts?

Activation Exercise

- Identify which of the fivefold ministries you are most influenced by and thank a leader who walks in that gift.
- Pray for the fivefold ministry leaders in your life.

Week 5: The Gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12)

Key Scripture

1 Corinthians 12:7 (NKJV) – "But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all."

Main Teaching

- The Nine Gifts of the Spirit fall into three categories:
 - Revelation Gifts: Word of Wisdom, Word of Knowledge, Discerning of Spirits
 - Power Gifts: Faith, Healing, Miracles
 - Vocal Gifts: Prophecy, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues

Reflection Questions

1. Which of the gifts of the Spirit do you desire to grow in?

- 2. Have you experienced any of these gifts in your life?
- 3. How can you stir up these gifts?

Activation Exercise

- Ask the Holy Spirit to activate one of these gifts in your life.
- Step out in faith and operate in the Spirit's leading.

Week 6: Walking in Your Calling & Gifts

Key Scripture

2 Timothy 1:6 (NKJV) – "Stir up the gift of God which is in you."

Main Teaching

- We must steward, activate, and walk in our gifts daily.
- Overcoming fear, comparison, and passivity is essential.
- Growth comes through faithfulness, spiritual authority, and discipline.

Final Activation Exercise

 Write a commitment statement about how you will walk in your calling.

 Take one action step this week to use your gifts for God's Kingdom.

Final Prayer & Commitment

Father, thank You for my calling and the gifts You have given me. I commit to walking in them with boldness and obedience. Empower me with Your Spirit to serve, build, and glorify Your name. Amen.
