

The Finished Piece

Here is the piece as you last saw it. The rosettes have not been opened or shaped and the ruffle is unopened. The background is predominately a celery green.



Below are photos comparing unopened with opened and shaped rosettes. The rosettes on the right have been shaped with a needle and invisible thread.



I decided, after I had been looking at the scarf for a few weeks, that there was too much of a celery green and the background was a little too monotonous. I love the combination of rose and turquoise-y teal, so I mixed a diluted solution of turquoise and sky blue acid dye. I didn't measure the proportions, I just kept adding sky blue to turquoise until the turquoise was subdued and wasn't so "electric!"

Then, I hand-painted sections to give the piece more contrast and impact.



You can see the new turquoise-y blue sections contrasting with the pink and celery green. I am happy with the colour outcome. All the rosettes have been opened and shaped and the ruffles have been opened.
