God came to Balaam by night.

he formed

The Lord God took the man, whom he formed.

4.καὶ συνήγαγεν αὐτοὺς εἰς τὸν τόπον τὸν

And he gathered them in the place called in Hebrew, "Armageddon."

5. ὁμολογήσω αὐτοῖς ὅτι Οὐδέποτε² ἔγνων ὑμᾶς.
never

I will say to them that I never knew you.

¹ This is an example of how the genitive can be used to show time. "by night"

² This is a VERY strong way to say "never." It means "not at any time!"
