Notes appear below in the order they occur in the book.

B is played on the open 2nd string.      D is played by the 3rd finger in the 3rd fret of the 2nd string.      G is played on the open 3rd string.      E is played on the open 1st string.

A is played by the 2nd finger in the 2nd fret of the 3rd string.      C is played by the 1st finger in the 1st fret of the 2nd string.      F is played by the 1st finger in the 1st fret of the 1st string.      G is played by the 3rd finger in the 3rd fret of the 1st string.

A is played by the 4th finger in the 5th fret of the 1st string.      F is played by the 3rd finger in the 3rd fret of the 4th string.      E is played by the 2nd finger in the 2nd fret of the 4th string.      D is played on the open 4th string.

Bb is played by the 3rd finger in the 3rd fret of the 3rd string.      D# is played by the 4th finger in the 4th fret of the 2nd string.      C# is played by the 2nd finger in the 2nd fret of the 2nd string.      G# is played by the 1st finger in the 1st fret of the 3rd string.

F# is played by the 2nd finger in the 2nd fret of the 1st string.      A is played on the open 5th string.      E is played on the open 6th string.      F is played by the 1st finger in the 1st fret of the 6th string.

G is played by the 3rd finger in the 3rd fret of the 6th string.      B is played by the 2nd finger in the 2nd fret of the 5th string.      C is played by the 3rd finger in the 3rd fret of the 5th string.

Bb is played by the 1st finger in the 1st fret of the 5th string.      A# is played by the 1st finger in the 1st fret of the 5th string.      G# is played by the 4th finger in the 4th fret of the 6th string.
