Quin Gold	<p>My Pallet Setup This is the way my pallet is set up. If you already have yours set up in a way that works for you use the empty wells for my suggested colors.</p> <p>Setting your pallet up for the first time I like to organize my pallet into families of color leaving enough space in between the grouping of color with empty wells to add additional new colors or mixes.</p> <p>If you like you can set your pallet up like a color wheel with the complimentary color on the other side of the pallet. This way it is easier to mix a neutral grey but personally I never think of it in that way. Mine is not set up like a color wheel but you do have that option</p> <p>Label your color. Using a permanent marker, label the side of the pallet or write on a piece of artist's tape then match to the corresponding color. This will help you to get to know the colors you like to work with.</p>				Quin Magenta
