Attend 1-hr classes for 6 weeks to practice the weekly material in front of instructor for feedback.





COURSE IS SELF-PACED


You still have a year to take the 6 week course online as well as have access to the Facebook group for feedback.

IN-PERSON FEEDBACK


When registering for the Level 3 course, you had to pick your in-person class to attend for 6 weeks. With in-person, it is expected you practiced the week skills before attending.

With access to the Facebook group, you can submit questions and videos mid-week to get more help before meeting in person.


VIDEO!

SUCCESSFUL CLASS TIPS

When you arrive, bring all your stuff into the training room and get your training area situated BEFORE bringing your dog in. The moment the dog is out of the car, you are training so think of what you want your dog to be learning. Keep your dog close; do NOT let your dog greet other dogs or jump on other people. Bring more treats than you think you will need, and gthen double that. You've got to get enough practice in for a full hour, so we need to make sure we've got plenty of treat fuel to get through that.
