

What is Digital Art


- Digital art is art that you create on your computer or online.
- It can be used for online marketing and branding.
- It can be used for creating assets for physical products.
- You can think of digital art as "painting and scrapbooking on your computer" versus with pen, paper and scissors.

Things to Keep in Mind When Creating Digital Art

- When creating graphics for the Internet, you can use low resolution images at 72 dpi (dots per inch).
- However when creating digital designs for print or to turn into physical products, you need to be able to save your designs as high quality, high resolution images at 300 dpi.
- Programs to consider for high resolution digital art:
- Photoshop (monthly fee)
 -Photoshop Elements (\$75-\$125)
 -Gimp (Free)
 -Procreate (iPad app)
- -PicMonkey.com (monthly fee)









PicMonkey.com Fun and Powerful Online Graphics Program

- It's like Canva in many ways yet has some different features.
- You need to be a paying member to use the program.
- They let you create and download high resolution images.

- Canva works best when creating web graphics.
- The download version that gives you a 300 dpi resolution is in PDF format. This is great for creating book covers and printable art.
- Print-on-demand sites usually need JPG or PNG image files.


Download the right file type

- Before downloading, be sure to check what file to download your design as since the design's quality varies on its purpose. Canva's available file types:
- JPG Small file size, best for photographs.PNG Supports transparency, best for
- graphics. • PDF: Standard - Best for illustrations, text,
- and graphics with a resolution of 96 dpi.
- PDF: Print Best for high quality prints with a resolution of 300 dpi.


