1.	Warm-up	Video	Daily Warm-up Routine I (pg. 13)
2.	Listening: Melody Only	Video	One, Two Buckle My Shoe – demonstration performance with scrolling music
3.	Get Ready to Play	Video	One, Two Buckle My Shoe <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Review Bs and Ds</li><li>- Identify and clap the quarter/eighth rhythm</li></ul>
4.	Component Practice	Video	One, Two... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Left hand and note names</li><li>- Right hand and finger alternating</li><li>- Putting it together</li></ul>
5.	Individual Practice	Teacher Directed	Students practice alone or in small groups
6.	Play-along: Full Ensemble	Video	One, Two Buckle My Shoe <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Adjust tempo as needed</li></ul>
7.	Change of Pace/ Brain Break	Teacher Directed	Student solos, games and videos etc. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the 'Activities and Videos' glossary in the Resources folder has ideas and links</li></ul>
8.	Preview Song	Teacher/Video	Check out and discuss <a href="#">12-Bar Blues</a> from Level 2 as performed by Curt Chambers and Lead Guitar students
