

Using FPDS-NG ezSearch is easy! Follow these steps:

- Go to the Federal Procurement Data System-Next Generation home page at the URL above
- Enter a "search" criteria into the ezSearch box



- The "Sort By" feature box using the "Date Signed" parameter will find the most recent information
- You can narrow your results by specific government agency, top 10 departments, contracting activities, or vendors
- Click on "view" to see additional details on the contract including dollar value
- You can export your search results into a spreadsheet




## Benefits of using FPDS-NG:


- No need to register to search the database
- Database houses award data for all federal contracts in excess of \$3,500
- Use data to match the product or service that you want to sell to government contracting offices
- All contract information is available to the public –
  Note...public posting of Department of Defense Award data is delayed for 90 days


### Finding Contractors' Points of Contact from FPDS-NG

1. Type in search criteria (contract number, contractor's name, etc.)




#### 2. Select "View"







3. In this case, the phone number isn't listed. To find the phone number and point of contact for this company, obtain the DUNS No. See the DUNS below: 140733242




4. Go to the System for Award Management website (www.sam.gov). Click on "Search Records."




### 5. Insert the DUNS.
