You'll also need the following supplies:
 Primed canvas or panel (16"x12" or the same proportion) Liquin from Winsor & Newton or other alkyd medium (for oil painters) Artists' Painting Medium from Winsor & Newton (for oil painters) – used in Stage 4 Conte pencil or other drawing tool Kneaded eraser
 Spray fixative (I recommend Workable Fixatif from Krylon) Odorless Mineral Spirits, turpentine, or turpentine substitute (for oil painters) Note: I'm using Gamsol for the imprimatura stage. Once that's done, I use Chelsea's Lavender Brush Cleaner.
 Container for mineral spirits (oil painters) or for water (acrylic painters) Rubber or nitrile gloves Paper towels Palette Small palette knife Ruler
Scissors and/or X-Acto style knife (for making custom brushes)
