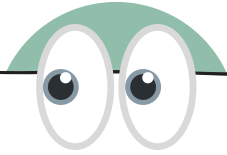




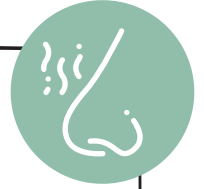

What does your current environment look like? Have a look around and take note of all the different types of input you are receiving.

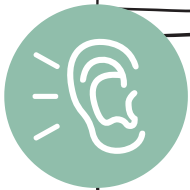
What can you see?
