

The chart below shows the changes in three different areas of crime in Manchester city centre from 2003-2012.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features and making comparisons where relevant.

We can ignore the second line, as this is the same for each question and just gives instructions



You might want to take this opportunity to practice your planning strategy as well, remember to read and understand all the information given, find the Overall Trend and Anomaly, select the important numbers and divide the chart.

First Sentence – (Paraphrase the question) The line graph explains how crime rates for Burglary, Car Theft and Robbery in Manchester city centre have changed over the long-term period between 2003 and 2012.


Second Sentence – (Overall Trend and Anomaly) Overall we can see that crime rates have fallen, particularly in the case of Burglary, but while Robbery has remained stable, the number of Car Thefts has increased.

So, here is our completed Intro Paragraph:






The graph shows the proportion of the population aged 65 and over between 1940 and 2040 in three different countries.
