## Short Major ii V I Lick

In this major ii V I line, you use the Am7 arpeggio to outline Am7, leading to the scale over D7, then resolving to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and root of Gmaj7.

Start by learning this line until you can play it from memory, on your own, with a metronome, and over a backing track.

Then, alter the rhythms, change some notes, leave some notes out, add in hammers, pull-offs, and slide, etc. to personalize the phrase.

Have fun as you add this classic line to your major ii-V-I vocabulary.
