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Why and Who?

Why Do We Need It?

- All of my *ruqyah* courses have been done for other institutes.
- It's easy to be satisfied with something which isn't really good enough.
- I want to gather in-depth knowledge on the topic, in a way that I can add to over time.
- There is a desperate need for authentic knowledge on this topic - taken from the Qur'ān and the Sunnah, and the books of the experts on this topic throughout time.
- There is a desperate need to teach people how to do ruqyah, to help themselves, their families, and others - with the permission of Allāh.

Why and Who?

Who is it For?

- People who are interested in learning more about the world of the unseen - jinn, magic, the evil eye, etc.
- People who are afflicted or fear they might be.
- People who are supporting friends or family members that are suffering from afflictions.
- People who are interested in ruqyah for medical reasons.
- People who want to learn ruqyah to help others by the permission of Allāh.
- It is **not** for those who want to learn this knowledge for fame and/or fortune - they are the inheritors of the people of Fir'awn.

Course Format

How the Course is Structured (I)

- Hosted on Teachable, which can be viewed online or with the iOS app.
- Split into 11 main sections.
- One section is released each Saturday. If someone signs up late, they automatically have access to all of the content which has been previously released.
- Every section contains a live lecture, which takes place Sunday 4.30pm GMT.
- The live lecture page for each week has embedded live chat.
- If you aren't able to watch the live class, an edited version is uploaded shortly after.

Course Format

How the Course is Structured (II)

- Every section contains a Q&A page, connected to the theme, with a link to a form where you can submit your questions.
- Please only submit short questions, not whole case histories.
- Q&A videos are uploaded during the week.
- Several weeks of the course have bonus videos - these are usually related to the theme of the week, but not covered within the main lecture.
- Notes are uploaded once they are available.

Pre-Course Material

Getting Started

- There are three videos which are available before the first week.
- These are short videos which are useful to watch before the first live lecture on Sunday 9th January.
- Apart from this video, there is a video explaining some of the most common words that people use.
- There is also a video which talks a little bit about the virtue and importance of the topic.
- If the video isn't available when you first log in, just check back in a few hours - and it should be there.

Week One

The World of the Unseen

- The theme of this week is the world of the unseen.
- This includes an introduction to the concept of the unseen world, and some of the things that the unseen world contains.
- This includes the world of the jinn.
- Our live lecture is: "Ibn Taymiyyah's Insight into the World of the Unseen"
- Q&A is on the same theme.

Week Two

Protection from Evil

- The theme of this week is protection from the evils of the unseen world.
- This includes a discussion on the role of belief in Allāh in protecting a person.
- We also discuss the concept of *taqwaa* and guarding what Allāh commanded you to guard, and why these two are mentioned directly in relation to being protected.
- Our live lecture is: "Staying Safe - A Step by Step Guide to Protection for You and Your Family"
- There is also a bonus video demonstrating the *adhkaar* that are most important for protection.

Week Three

The Reality of Magic

- The theme of this week is the reality of magic.
- This includes a discussion on different forms of magic and associated ruling, as well as understanding how magic works in detail.
- We also discuss the purposes of magic, and the tools, objects, and symbols used by magicians in different cultures.
- Our live lecture is: "A Brief History of Magic - From the Time of Sulaymān Until Today"
- There is also a bonus video "The Secrets of Ta'weez" where we break down the meaning of various amulets.

Week Four

Magicians & Healers

- The theme of this week is magicians and healers.
- This includes those who practice real magic, those who perform tricks, fraudsters, as well as those who offer *ruqyah* services or faith healing.
- We discuss the attributes of a real *raaqi*, as well as talking in detail about paying for ruqyah. We highlight common mistakes and misconceptions, and common warning signs.
- Our live lecture is: "Friend or Fraud...How to Tell the Difference Between a Rāqi, a Rip-Off, and a Real Magician?"
- This week there is a bonus interview, where I chat with Abu Muhammad Basak about our journey in learning ruqyah, and ask his thoughts on choosing a raaqi.

Week Five

The Evil Eye

- The theme of this week is the evil eye.
- This includes defining what the evil eye really is and finding out about its symptoms and how to diagnose it.
- We discuss the misconceptions that people have, as well as the best way to treat the evil eye, depending on the circumstances.
- Our live lecture is: "The Evil Eye: Fact vs Fiction"
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

Week Six

First Steps to Treatment

- The theme of this week is the first steps to diagnosing and treating a problem - in other words: where do we begin?
- The goal is not to cover everything, but at least to be able to take effective first steps.
- Our live lecture is: "I Think I'm Afflicted...What Now?"
- There is a bonus lecture showing you a full demonstration of how to do the "7 day programme"
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

Week Seven

Diagnosis in Detail

- The theme of this week is how to diagnose cases in detail, going beyond the first steps of diagnosis into something more specific.
- This includes how to separate between afflictions of the unseen and medical conditions, as well as things like *waswasah*, which lie between the two.
- Our live lecture is: "Possessed or Psychosis - How Do We Know?"
- I hope to arrange a special bonus interview for this week, but I'm waiting to confirm.
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

Week Eight

Treatment in Detail

- The theme of this week is treatment in detail, going beyond the first steps of treatment, and building upon the detailed diagnosis to put together a complete ruqyah plan.
- Our live lecture is: "The Perfect Programme - Putting Together a Ruqyah Plan for Every Affliction"
- There is a bonus video showing a complete demonstration of ruqyah.
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

Week Nine

Prophetic Medicine

- The theme of this week is the use of prophetic medicine along with ruqyah. This includes everything from Costus and cupping to *zamzam* water.
- Our live lecture is: "Tools of the Trade - What We Can Use From Prophetic Medicine"
- There is a bonus video introducing cupping and how to get started.
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

Week Ten

Advanced Ruqyah

- The theme of this week is advanced ruqyah - going beyond the basics.
- Our live lecture is: "The Ten Methods of Ruqyah"
- We also discuss practices that are often presented as "advanced ruqyah" like jinn-catching, beating, visioning, and asking help from those who can see the jinn, or from Muslim jinn.
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

Week Eleven

Problems & Challenges

- The theme of this week is overcoming problems and challenges.
- This includes long-term cases that never seem to end, magic being renewed, the patient refusing ruqyah, or patients for whom ruqyah can't be performed.
- Our live lecture is: "Will it Ever End? - Strategies for Patients with Long-Term Suffering"
- This includes testimony from those who have overcome long-term suffering, or other severe challenges successfully - and how they did it.
- Q&A this week is on the same theme.

After The End

A Course That Keeps on Going

- Although I believe that the 11 weeks will cover a huge amount of beneficial content, I also know that there is so much more knowledge that can be learnt and passed on.
- While I don't mind doing ruqyah courses for other institutes and occasional events in person, I want this course to be the thing that I go back to.
- For that reason, I plan to continue to add content (and as long as you are registered, you'll have access).
- I also want feedback from students and those who are practising ruqyah as to things that need to be clarified and expanded upon.
- If they are connected to the existing themes, more "bonus content" can be added to each week. If there are completely new themes, then new "bonus weeks" can be added.
- Most of this will be pre-recorded, but I also hope that some of it can be live.
