

Avoir, être

INTRO

These verbs certainly are the most common ones in the language. They have a tricky conjugation but must be learned by heart, as well as a minimum of structures (check next lesson for more).

DETAILS

Avoir and *être* are also auxiliaries used to form other tenses so, you better buckle up, because you'll be using those all the time.

Être = to be

Je suis

Tu es

Il, elle, on est

Nous sommes

Vous êtes

Ils, elles sont

Avoir = to have

J'ai

Tu as

Il, elle, on a

Nous avons

Vous avez

Ils, elles ont

=> Make sure to pronounce "ils / elles ss sont" and "ils / elles z ont".
Check the recordings.

USE IT

Être + characteristics of personalities, physical description

Avoir + item owned

Examples:

Je suis une fille. = I am a girl.

Nous avons une maison. = We have a house.
