- Apron
- 1 plastic dollar store tablecloth
- Misc. stamps and stencils
- Newspapers-needed throughout class as work surface
- Scissors, ruler, pencil
- Tub of Baby wipes
- Roll of paper towels
- Plastic old gift card-used as a spreading tool
- Few sheets of sandpaper, fine grit 150-220
- 1 National Geographic Magazine 1995 or newer
- 8oz. jar of acrylic white gesso, you can use white acrylic paint too.



- 16 oz or larger of Golden it was called Polymer Gloss but now is called Gloss Medium
- Glazing medium, by Golden
- Found papers, old book pages, maps, letter engineer plans, Brown lunch bags, or grocery food bags etc.
- Paint brushes, 1" flat, 1-small pointed for fine detail and shading, 2" chip brush from the hardware store.
- Acrylic paints, in bottle works best but can use tubes. Golden Brand works best for Stained tissue papers. A variety of acrylics colors to select from is good.
- 140lb. watercolor paper few sheets of at least 11 x 14 we can cut to size. (Cold or hot press)
- Stamps and things that create texture on the surface. This will be you mark you make on you papers so look around the house for some fun things
- Stencils
- Roll of Wax paper or a box of wax deli sheets. This will go between the paper, so they don't stick together.
- Ephemeral, beads, thread, crewel needles, buttons
- Wax Crayons, Caran d'ache or watercolor pencils or pastel pencils, great for line detail
- Water container for brushes, stamping and stencil items.



- Spray Bottle for Water
- Cosmetic Sponges (3) should be good.
