

# Stabilizer for machine embroidery

# Medium cutaway stabilizer

A cutaway stabilizer stays in your garment. A medium weight stabilizer is ideal for rugged clothing.

# Fusible poly mesh stabilizer

A fusible poly mesh is also a cutaway stabilizer, but it can be ironed onto the garment. It is an ideal stabilizer to use when you are embroidering on knit garments.

### Adhesive backed tear away stabilizer

A stabilizer tears away from the embroidery. It's an ideal stabilizer for projects that do not require permanent stabilization. It can be used as a base for floating projects.

#### Water soluble stabilizer

This stabilizer dissolves completely in water. It's an ideal stabilizer for in-the-hoop or free-standing lace projects when you want the stabilizer to completely disappear after the project is done.

## Water soluble topper

A water soluble topper should be used when embroidering on nappy fabrics like towels. It tamps down the fibers in the fabric to keep them from poking through the stitching.

### Cloud Cover or Fuse So Soft or Tender Touch

A material that fuses to the back of the embroidered area on a garment to prevent skin irritation.

#### **Heat n Bond Lite**

A material that is fused to applique fabric to prevent raveling and to help it stick to your project.
