

Hands on at Home Sand and Water Play

Oh no! The toys are dirty! Today we will be doing a fun pretend play muddy toy wash!

This will be aimed at socio-emotional development.



2 waterproof containers

Sano

Spoon of cocoa or drinking chocolate (mud)
Gentle liquid soap

Toys (plastic farm animals, trucks, dinosaurs, dolls)

Wate

Towels

Other washing items e.g. sponge, cloth, brush.





Method:

- 1. In one container mix sand, cocoa, water and a few drops of the liquid soap so the sand is sticky. Your toddler can have free play time to mix and explore
- 2. Add some toys e.g. plastic farm animals and let your toddler "pretend play" with the animals and see how they get all "muddy." They will need a wash!
- 3. Put some water and a squirt of gentle soap into your second container. Let your toddler splash the water around and it will become foamy
- 4. Encourage your child to talk to his/her animals and give them a wash

5. Add sponges, cloths and brushes for more creative play

6. Dry toys with a towel





Activity Tip:

Upgrade - model to your toddler how to empathize with a toy e.g. "I know you don't like having your hair washed but Look, I am making sure that no soap gets in your eyes."

Practice social skills e.g. you and your child can take turns to wash and do a clean up after the activity.

Talk about the importance of cleaning with your toddler and why we have a bath and wash and why it is important to wash your animal or car.

Downgrade - demonstrate and talk about each step with your toddler and encourage Lots of copying and pretend play.
