



How successful is training?

From study 'Evaluation and treatment for SA in dogs' 2000: (Owner evaluation/poor training techniques)

- ▶ 15% Cured
- ► 68% improve
- ▶ 17% same, rehomed or euthanised
- Mixed breed less likely to respond to treatment





Treatment Plan: 6 areas

Wellness Program Management Attachment repair Training Enrichment Support



Wellness Program

- Healthy check
- Diet
- Exercise
- Social time
- Rest





- Establish your parameters
- Keep a stats diary
- Film your dog for a 15-30 min absence for diagnosis
- Continue to film throughout training at set intervals to monitor progress

(clinical support)


Raise Confidence

Training to raise self worth, feelings of control and choice.




Enrichment (EMRA, ZOOS, FARMS)

A spatial judgement task to determine background emotional state in laboratory rats

Does a more positive emotional state induce better learning and more positive choices?



- 1. Independence training
- 2. Desensitisation of departure cues
- 3. Chill mat a safe place which captures relaxation
- 4. Non interaction marker there are times when your not available

5. Training plan daily and before ANY departure
