1. White should play h3, restrict Black light-square Bishop.

4. White should play Ne5, occupying central e5 square and build up attacking on the Kingside.
5. 12.Bxh7+ ! Kxh7 13.Qh5+ Kg8 14.Qxf7+ Kh7 15.Qh5+ Kg8 16.Qxe8+
6. Bf6! Sacrifice and destroy Black King's shelter
7. Qc2, prevent Bf5
8. Qe2, prevent Nb4
