SURFACE:

Select any size – 140# or 300# paper (I use Arches 300# paper CP)

If you want to paint paper attached to a cradled panel you can view my video for free at anitawood.teachable.com. This eliminates the need for glass and framing.

BRUSHES:

I typically use rounds for watercolor – from size 6 to 16. I prefer Sable/Synthetic blend

A good wash brush is important – either goat hair or synthetic flat.

The Wash Brush that I am currently using is:

Winsor & Newton Goat Hair

A photo is included and the brushes are in order:

.toothbrush for scrubbing – soft & medium

.Winsor & Newton Series 240 size 1

.Cheap Joe's Fritch Scrubber – various sizes

.Synthetic Brush size 4

.Synthetic Brush size 10

.Cheap Joe's Ugly Brush – size 6 & 8 made for masking fluid, but nice for painting

.Princeton NEPTUNE this is size 4, but I'll be investing in other sizes too

.Escoda Reserva Kolinsky Tajmyr I like sizes 10

.Escoda Reserva Kolinsky Tajmyr I like sizes 12

OTHER SUPPLIES:

Masking fluid and brush – (non permanent) I always use Pebeo Drawing Gum

Masking Fluid eraser – called Rubber Cement Pickup

Watercontainer, paper towels, plastic for table protection, hair dryer

Artist Graphite to transfer drawings to watercolor paper

Kneaded Eraser for making graphite lines lighter
