

Directed them when they were confused
Prodded them when they were reluctant
Encouraged them when they were downhearted

Servant Leadership

Servant Leadership is exercising real, godly leadership, as Christ did when He used a towel, and influencing, equipping, and empowering people to accomplish God's purpose and plan.

The Servant-Leader Is a Shepherd


They do that by:

Feeding it (John 21:15-17; 2 Tim. 4:1-2),

Protecting it (Acts 20:28; 2 Tim. 4:2-3)

Maturing it (Eph. 4:11-16).





Servant leaders, however, look at leadership as an act of service.

They embrace and welcome feedback as a source of useful information on how they can provide better service



Servant Leadership alignment

When the <u>Heart</u>, <u>Head</u>, <u>Hands</u>, and Habits are aligned, extraordinary levels of loyalty, trust, and productivity will result. When they are out of alignment, frustration, mistrust, and diminished long-term productivity are the result




The journey of servant leadership...

that starts in the **Heart** with motivation and intent must travel through another internal domain, that of the **Head**, which is the leader's belief system and perspective on the role of the leader

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVANT LEADERSHIP

A dishonest leader breeds dishonest followers

Prov 29:12 (NIV) "If a ruler listens to lies, all his officials become wicked."



DISHONESTY DISQUALIFY LEADERSHIP

- Dishonesty should disqualify anybody from leadership
- Ex 18:21 (NIV) "But select capable men from all the people – men who fear God, trustworthy men who hate dishonest gain
 and appoint them as officials over thousands, hundreds, fifties and tens."

Effective Appeal of a servant Leader

- 1. Be in Right Standing
- 2. Have the Right Motives
- 3. Choose the Appropriate Time
- 4. Gather Accurate Information
- 5. Demonstrate the Right Attitudes
- 6. Use the Appropriate Words
- 7. Give the Right Response





DEVELOP A HEALTHY FEAR OF DISCIPLINE

Heb 12:11 (NIV) " No <u>discipline</u> seems pleasant at the time but painful. Later on however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it."

SET FIRM BOUNDARIES

□ Set firm and clear boundaries regarding your actions and do not veer from them Gen 4:7 (NIV) "If you do what is right will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you but you must master it."

BE WARY AT ALL TIMES


