2.	Review Songs	Teacher Directed	Cielito Lindo, Greensleeves
3.	Music Reading	Video	Key Signatures
4.	Listening: Melody with Score	Video	Minuet in G – demonstration performance with scrolling music
5.	Get Ready to Play	Video	Get Ready to Play – Minuet in G <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Not really by Bach!</li> <li>- G Major</li> <li>- Antecedent and consequent phrases</li> <li>- Cadence</li> </ul>
6.	Component Practice 1	Video	Component Practice Video 1 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Measures 1-4</li> </ul>
7.	Component Practice 2	Video	Component Practice Video 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Measures 4-8 + 15 and 16</li> </ul>
8.	Individual Practice	Teacher Directed	Students practice alone or in small groups.
9.	Change of Pace/ Brain Break	Teacher Directed	Student solos, games and videos etc. the 'Activities and Videos' glossary in the Resources folder has ideas and links
10.	Play-Along: Full Ensemble	Video	Minuet in G Ensemble Play-Along Video <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Guided class play-through</li> <li>- Adjust tempo as needed</li> </ul>
11.	Summary and Closing	Teacher Directed	Summarize and review the learning targets for this lesson (found below). Close with one more full class/ensemble performance of Minuet in G
