



Learn how to create stylized tangles with incredible 3-dimensional depth. You will need:

- * 2-3 Tan Renaissance tiles. I use official Zentangle tiles, but you can also use tan colored card stock. Keep in mind that results might not be as dramatically metallic as over Zentangle® tiles.
- * White gel pen. I use Sakura Gelly Roll 10.
- * White charcoal pencil. I use Zentangle's white Charcoal or White General's Charcoal or White Conte a Paris or Faber Castell's White Medium Pitt Pastel or Derwent Chinese White
- * Brown inking pen. I use Derwent Graphic Sepia 0.1
- * Light honey brown colored pencil. I use Faber Castell Brown Ochre.
- * Dark brown colored pencil. I use Faber Castell Burnt Umber
- * Graphite pencil. I use Staedtler mars Lumograph F pencil.
- * Blending stump and/or blending marker
- * Optional: Light Gray colored pencil.
- * Journal for notes and practice.
