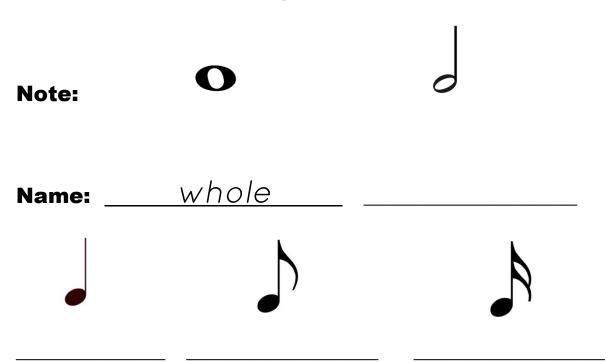
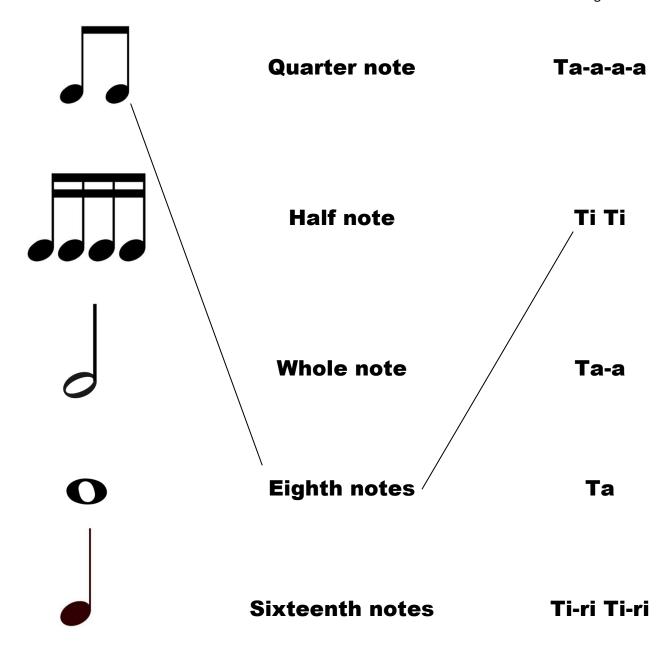

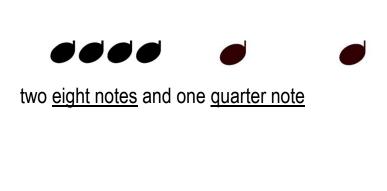

two <u>quarter notes</u>, two <u>eighth notes</u> and four <u>16th notes</u>

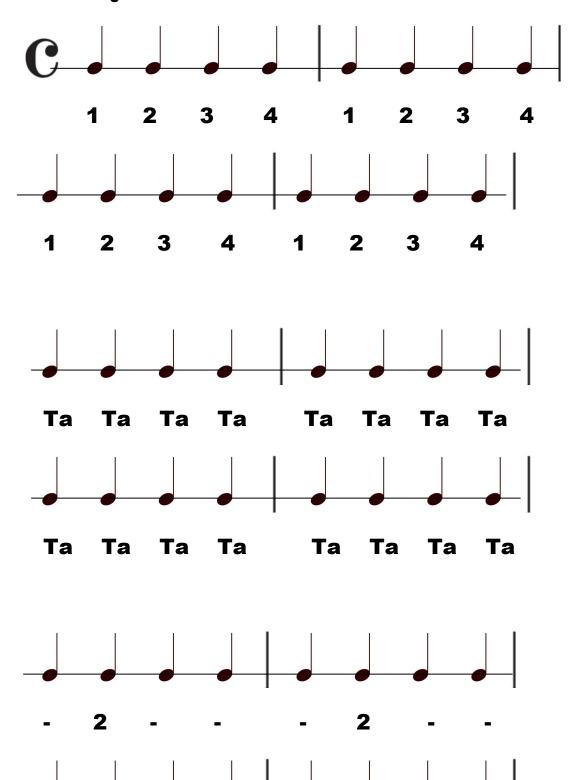




4. Play the mp3 *Cheerleader* and keep the beat:

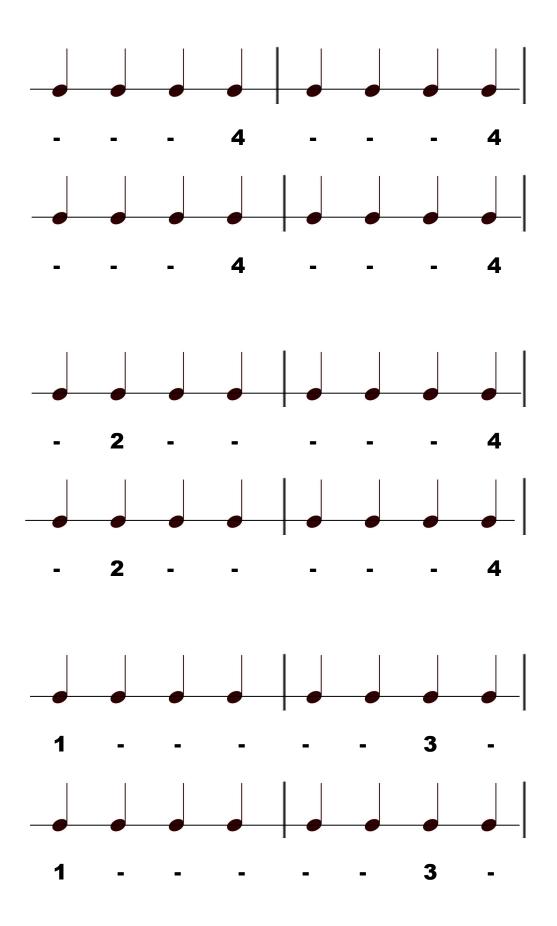
- a. Start with the slower track, then try faster!

- e. Keep clapping, but only say the beats written down!

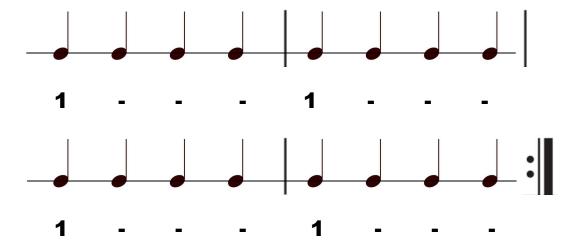
f. Count as written below! If you run out of notes, go back to beginning and do it again!
