How To: Pick The Right Crate



There are 5 main types of Crate:

- Fabric crates
- Folding wire crates
- Hard plastic crates
- Heavy duty crates
- Furniture (sometimes called Fashion) Crates



Fabric Crates

Pros:

- Lightweight
- Comfortable
- Easy to Clean

Cons:

- Destructible
- Solid sides
- Enclosed

Wire Folding Crates



Pros:

- Come in lots of Sizes
- Folding
- Uninterrupted view of the house
- Easy to Clean
- Two doors

Cons:

- Can be uncomfortable if not padded

Hard Plastic Crates



Pros:

- Portable
- Sturdy
- Handy for dogs who are 'on the go' with their owners
- Used for cars and planes

Cons:

- Only really for small to medium dogs
- Enclosed at the sides

Heavy Duty Crates

- Great for escape artists
