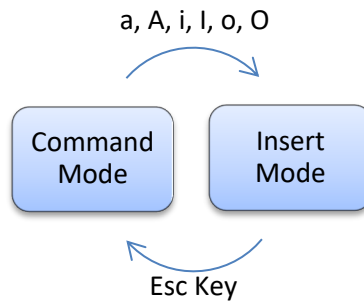


The vi Text Editor

The vi (pronounced "vee-eye") is a text editor like Notepad. To start using vi, type the following command in the Linux shell: **vi filename**

(where **filename** can be the name of an existing file or the name of a file you wish to create)

When working with vi you will be in one of two modes: **Command Mode** and **Insert Mode**.



Entering Insert Mode	Command
Insert text after the cursor	a
Insert text before the cursor	i
Insert text at the end of the current line	A
Insert text at the start of the current line	I
Open a new line below the current line	o
Open a new line above the current line	O
Entering Command Mode	Esc Key
Quitting vi	
Quit and save changes	ZZ or :wq
Quit without saving changes	:q!
Quit and save to another file (save as)	:w file
Quit (this will give a prompt if changes have been made)	:q
Moving The Cursor In A File	
Next character	l
Previous character	h
Next word	w
Previous word	b
Start of current line	0 (zero)
End of current line	\$
Next line down (same column)	j
Previous line (same column)	k
Deleting Text	
Current character	x
Current word	dw
Entire line	dd
To end of line	d\$
To start of line	d0 (zero)
