Addressing a wide range of goals they discuss how humour is not only fun, it also works very well to reduce anxiety and rehearse coping with the unexpected - a key area of need for autistic children. Ann & Janet discuss lyric substitution, incongruity and exaggeration and useful tools to increase creativity. They also discuss bringing fun and the unexpected into movement activities and how to use a range of music-based techniques to build suspense, increase tolerance for change and encourage laughter and engagement. The tutorial also includes Janet & Ann's tips for useful props and activity ideas which you can adapt to your own clinical work. The tutorial closes with a summary and 3 bonus content activities if you'd like to extend your learning or earn extra CMTE/CPPD credits.
