

Xmas Table Runner 2021

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This table runner consists of 4 9.5 x 9.5 inch blocks on point and is approx. 51 inches long. They each have a Christmas themed Applique.

This project is quick and easy. Great for a last minute decision to decorate the table. I will be making placemats out of the same appliques.

You will need a sewing machine and any serger.

What you need to know

This project is primarily made out of scraps, mainly strips. I chose to use Kaffe Fassett fabric because that is my `thing` but you could use any fabric and color coordinate it with your Xmas decorations or even use Xmas fabric. So the supply list is sparse but that is good because you probably already have everything in your stash.

I made 4 blocks. I am going to be adding an additional star block after my Live 12/6

I chose to alternate red and green. However, I only had a small amount of green so the underside of my blocks are all red.

What I used for my runner of 4 blocks

2/3 yard of red cotton

1/3 yard of green cotton

1/3 Warm and Natural Batting.

Strips of fabric. You only need small strips. I made blue for the gift, red and yellow for the bauble and green for the tree. Be prepared to use some of the same fabrics in each block it add cohesion.

White fabric for the snowman and scarf fabric, stripes work good for that.

HeatnBond Lite. This is to cut out and fuse the applique shapes to the block.

Wonderfil Fruitti 12 weight for the flatlock stitch on the Xmas tree

Wonderfil Glamore for flatlock on the gift and bauble

Wonderfil Glamore and Fruitti in red, green and gold for the edge of the blocks

Kingstar gold metallic for quilting the blocks and attaching the appliques to the blocks on the sewing machine.

Rhinestones, buttons, charms can also be used to decorate it up when it is finished.
