

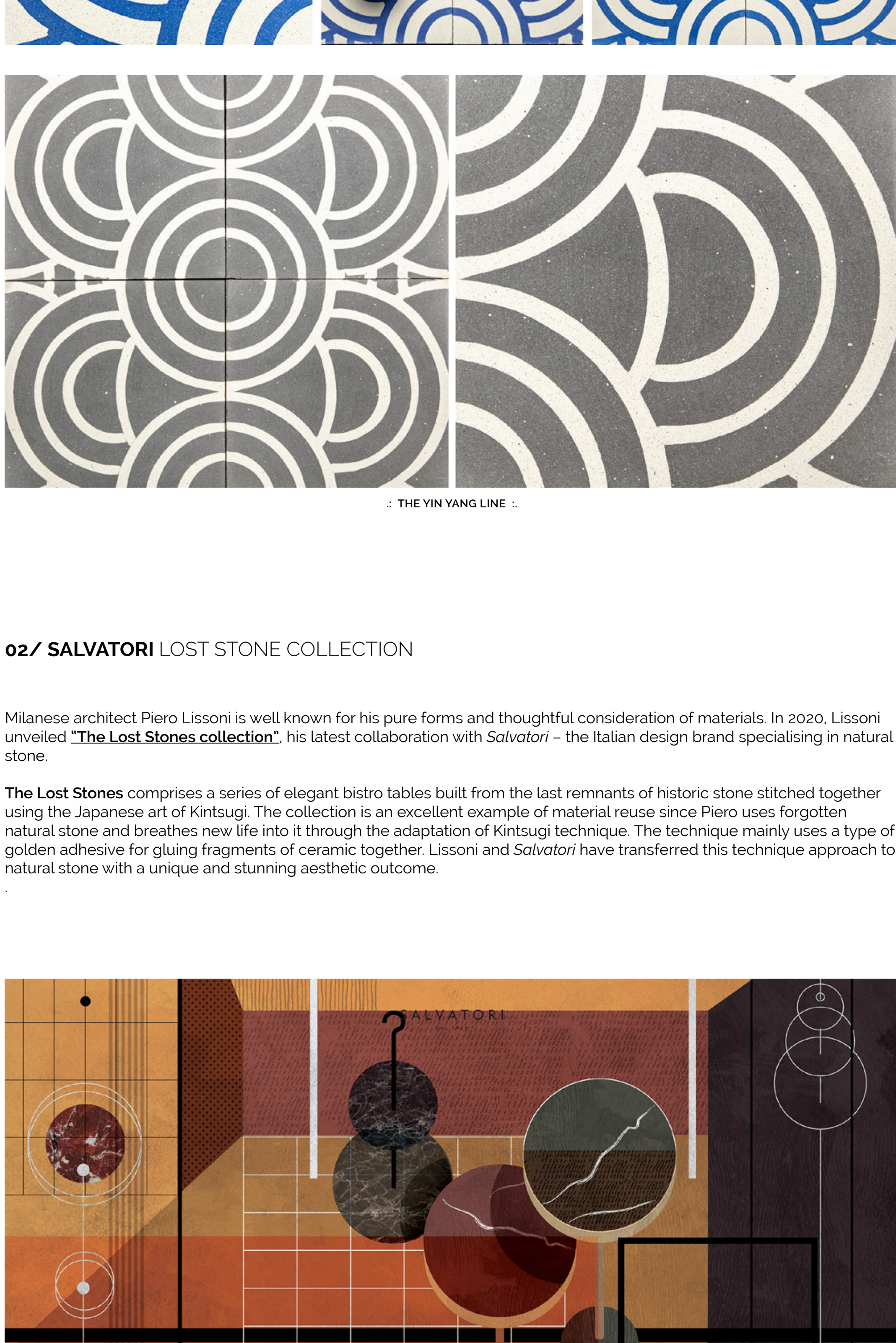

*Home Tres Chic* creates surfaces for interior décor while working closely with artisans. In 2020, after broad research in terms of design, colour palette and finishing technique, the Italian brand launched an innovative collection of cement tiles. The advanced collection method doesn't require chemicals or any protective paints. It does not need any treatment after installation, lasting over time without any maintenance.

The **YIN YANG line**, designed by Architect Barbara Fitzi and product development Silva Nocentini, was born from the oriental concept of opposites, which creates a cyclic movement that repeats itself indefinitely. Specular shapes and lines that interpenetrate and reject each other are at the same time complementary and opposites.

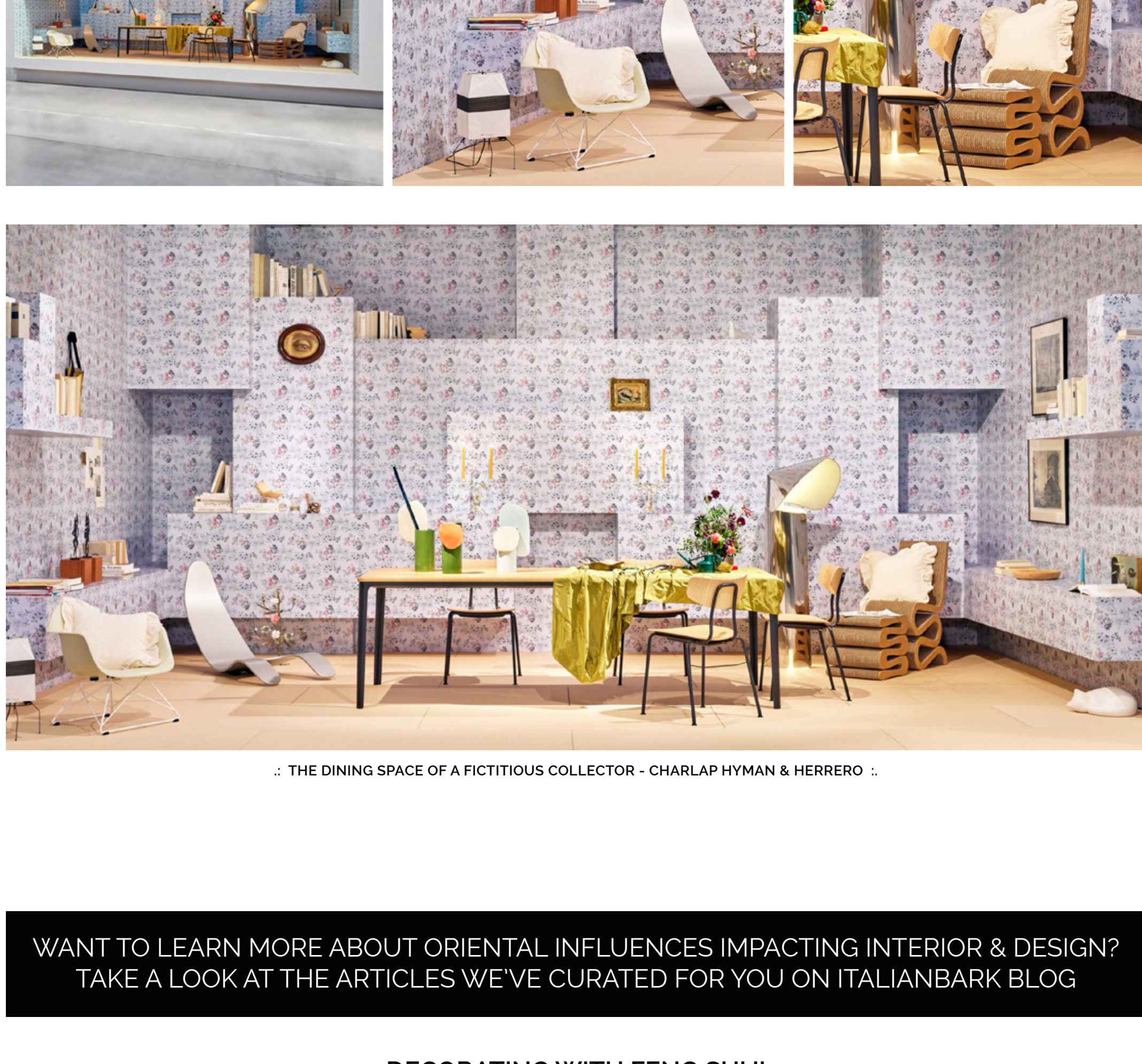



04/ **B&B ITALIA** AYANA OUTDOOR COLLECTION

In 2020, *B&B Italia* launched its new outdoor minimalist Ayana collection, in collaboration with Japanese designer Naoto Fukusawa. The protagonist of the Ayana collection is wood interpreted in an inventive way, with an oriental twist. While depths and heights refer to the south-east Asian tradition, the backrest recalls a Swedish wall bar, a piece of exercise

equipment turned into a load-bearing element.

The collection comprises a chair, a dining table and a low table. The dining chair structure is made of natural teak wood, and two generously padded cushions covered in fabric. The table stands out for its oval top in serpentine, a typical stone of the Alps. The supporting structure in natural teak appears light but is extremely robust, able to resist weather and support the heavy top. The teak is FSC certified (Forest Stewardship Council), and all the materials can be separated and disposed of with respect for the environment at the end of the product's life cycle.
