WHY DOES SIN NOT INVALIDATE GOD'S DREAM FOR ME?

1. JESUS ALREADY PAID FOR ALL MY SINS

2. GOD'S GOODNESS ISN'T BASED ON MY

3. GOD'S CALLING & GIFTS ARE GIVEN UNCONDITIONALLY
