

Speaking

The TOEFL ITP Speaking test¹ evaluates the skills needed to speak English in everyday situations, as well as some basic campus and academic settings — making it an ideal way for in-country institutions to measure a student's capabilities. It consists of one read-aloud task, two independent speaking tasks and one integrated speaking task.

- Testing Time: Approximately 15 minutes
- Number of Tasks: 4
- Total Score Range: 31–68
- CEFR Level: A2-C1
