How to import an agent zip file into DialogFlow (API.AI)


This is to answer a question I saw in the API.AI forums.

If you wish to import an agent's ZIP file to create a new agent within API.AI, you need to do only a few steps.


For this example, let us use the Florist shop zip file.

First, you create a new agent in API.AI.

Next, you select the Settings for the agent by clicking the gear icon right next to the agent name.



Next, you select the Export and Import tab.



Now you click on Import from Zip and select the local zip file.

EXPORT AS ZIP

Create a backup of the agent

RESTORE FROM ZIP

Replace the current agent version with a new one. All the intents and entities in the older version will be deleted.

IMPORT FROM ZIP

Upload new intents and entities without deleting the current ones. Intents and entities with the same name will be replaced with the newer version.

If you select the local zip file (for e.g. the florist.zip you downloaded in the previous step) during this step, API.AI will import the entire agent from the zip file for you.
