The Visayas region's six-month action plan included six vision casting sessions from January to March 2023 and three foundation schools from March to May.

Women's Wing (India): Hosted the inaugural South Asia Women's Virtual Conference on 12th August with 135 women leaders.

Sports In Disaster & Trauma: Amidst political unrest in Manipur, India, a mobilizing training was held for 55 pastors in Kangpokpi during 29-30 August. It provided hope in dire times, with a commitment to leverage sports ministry for community engagement.

All Ability Sports: Conducted a T.O.T for 12 All Ability School teachers in Nepal. This led to the KidsGames event on 18th March at Nepal Sports Fellowship (NSF) sports complex, enthusing 40 kids and 10 adults.

Sri Lanka's first National sports conference was held in June. It represented 21 denominations and Christian organizations, and appointed coordinators for seven regions.

// Elishamah Khan, a ninth-grader from Qila Didar Singh in Pakistan, was deeply moved by the Global Campfire online event. The transformative power of sports in propagating the Gospel and fostering discipleship captivated her.

Coming from a community where gender bias was rampant, she found hope in hearing about women actively leading and thriving in the realm of sports.

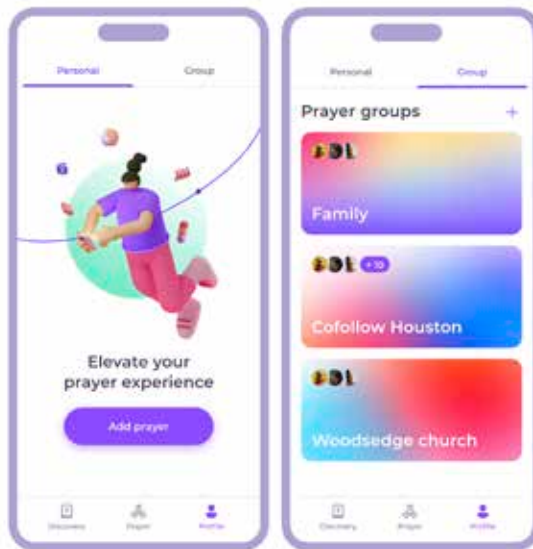

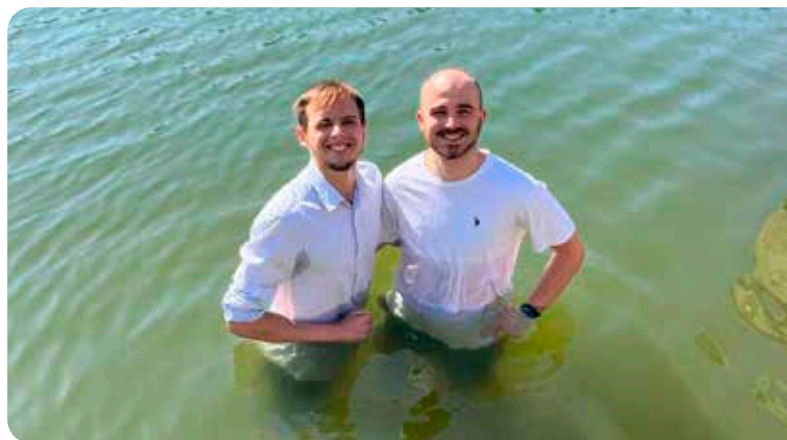
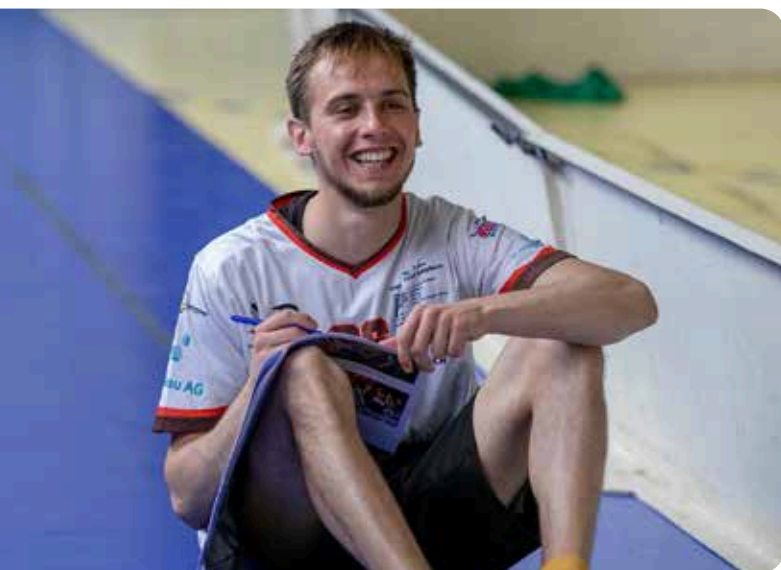

North Africa Middle East

In terms of Training & Leadership Development:
Four T.O.T sessions were held across 6 countries, nurturing 115 potential local leaders. Multiplication Schools expanded from 2 in 2022 to 5 in 2023. ReadySetGO Plus trainings increased from 9 in 2022 to 11 in 2023, with an additional 11 DMM trainings in the region. By 2023, the program trained over 5,535 leaders.

Europe GOFitness conducted 5 Zoom meetings this year, resulting in the creation of GOFitness networks in Italy, France, Romania, and Sweden, and held training sessions in Italy and Romania for approximately 10 local leaders in each location, who also provided fitness content.

ReadySetGO's inaugural meeting in Portugal saw 35 leaders in attendance.

French teams are gearing up for major sporting events like the Rugby World Cup and Paris Olympics, with numerous training sessions revitalizing city teams.

// In the picturesque island of Great Abaco in The Bahamas, where the population barely reached 17,000, a sports ministry team embarked on a mission that would change lives forever. Among the many young souls touched by their work, Derek Williams stood out as a testament to the transformative power of faith and community.

Derek, a 17-year-old from Murphy Town, had already endured more hardship than most people his age. Growing up as an orphan, he experienced the devastating loss of both his parents by the tender ages of 11 and 12. With only his sister by his side, Derek faced high school years marked by financial struggles and a profound sense of identity crisis. Matters became even more complicated when his sister left Abaco when Derek was just 15, leaving him to fend for himself.

It was during these precious moments on the court that Derek's path crossed with the sports ministry team. From 5 to 7 PM, they played basketball together and organized tournaments to showcase the talents of the community's young athletes. These gatherings paved the way for genuine connections, heartfelt conversations, and a deep sense of belonging.

As the team shared life, food, and games with Derek and his peers, something extraordinary began to happen. Derek felt the love of God in their midst, a love unlike any he had ever experienced before. Touched by this unconditional love, Derek made a life-changing decision. He opened up to the group and, with tears in his eyes, shared the burdens he had carried for the past six years. In the days that followed, Derek revealed his newfound faith, expressing that he had never felt such love from a group of people and had underestimated the outreach of the church.

The Experiential Team Adventure (ETA) was piloted with six disciple-making teams. ETA focuses on team building and understanding process dynamics. NASM mentors nurtured local teams in four cities. Through the training, 25 individuals united to form a cohesive national team.

The North American ReadySetGO conference which focuses on building relationships to advance God's Kingdom through Sports, Play, and Fitness was attended by 80 sports Ministry leaders from Canada, the US, and Mexico.

NASM hosted a Multiply School in partnership with Mexico.

31 leaders were trained in the Cup of Nations strategy to engage immigrants & refugees. Across the US, 10 Cup of Nations events reached over 2,220 refugees and immigrants.

NASM developed regional teams for GOSport, GOPlay, and GOFitness to provide strategy-specific training and to multiply disciple-making teams.

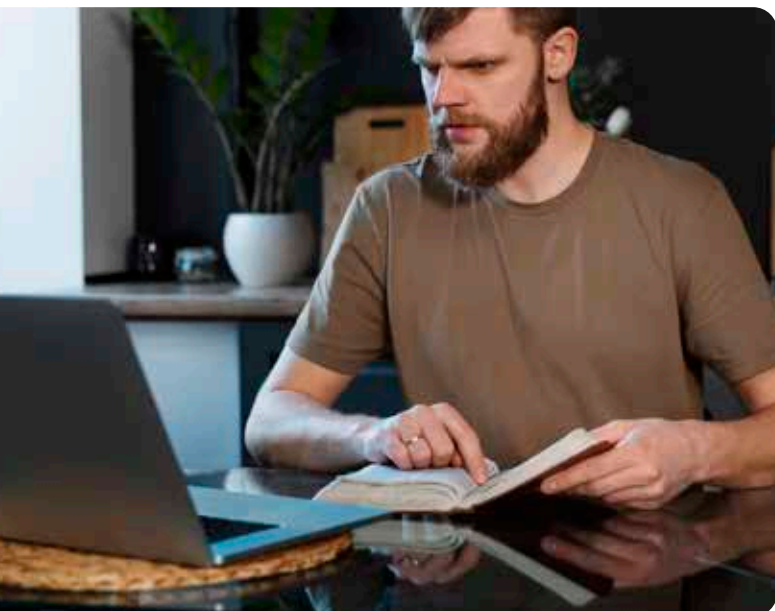
Shocked by the state of a local skate park, another group renovated it. This act not only provided a safe recreational spot but birthed a weekly skate church bible study led by local skaters.

// JB, a North American who grew up in a challenging environment, sought solace in the digital world of video games. A pivotal year during high school saw JB living with a supportive family, leading to a life-changing commitment to Christ.

In 2020, JB took charge of a video game-based ministry and led 15 students to camp. Transitioning to adulthood, he secured a job at a local hospital. Unexpectedly, JB's parents left him responsible for his 16-year-old brother. As the only stable adult, JB sought guardianship and gained legal responsibility.

Now, JB is not only his brother's guardian but also a mentor, provider, and advocate. He balances a full-time job, his brother's education, and involvement in a gaming ministry, ensuring his brother's well-being and spiritual growth. Living with mentors from a local gaming ministry, JB receives regular guidance toward a deeper relationship with Jesus. He's part of a tight-knit group of young men who meet for discipleship every Sunday night, further strengthening his faith journey.

// In 2018, a group of women from French-speaking West African countries united to promote sports and play ministry. Their small group quickly grew, and by 2020, it included women from Togo, Benin, Burkina Faso, Mali, and Côte d'Ivoire. Despite the pandemic in 2021, over 500 women from 13 nations connected online, sharing prayers, teachings, and testimonies.

A key figure in this movement was a woman supported by Logosdor, who played a crucial role in integrating translation into sports ministry. She represented Francophone Africa in a significant meeting in Orlando, focusing on translation strategies.

The Francophone African Women's Gathering in Doula, Cameroon, marked a significant milestone, attracting over 100 participants and emphasizing the importance of translation in their mission.

Against a backdrop of meticulous planning and passionate collaboration, a team emerged, ready to dive deep into the intricacies of translation. With mentors from across the globe, this team embarked on a mission — to weave sports ministry narratives for the 97 million French speakers.

With Rachel and Dalia leading the charge, this movement's story is a testament to dedication, unity, and vision. Their journey, captured beautifully in images and videos, stands as an inspiration for many, resonating with the essence of community and purpose.

// In Barbados, the Multiply School achieved remarkable results in 2022 and 2023, with 15 participants from various churches, nearly equally split between males and females. Five out of eight graduates actively pursued ministry plans, showcasing their commitment to both sports and faith. The success story of Thonny, who transitioned from a participant in Dominica in 2016 to becoming the leader of the Multiply School in Haiti in 2023, was particularly inspiring.

In Haiti, the 2023 launch of the Haitian Creole-speaking Multiply School was a promising start, with 24 participants representing 18 cities, 15 churches, and 4 para-church ministries. Out of these, 22 successfully completed ministry plans, potentially leading to the birth of nine new ministries and four teams. Despite challenging circumstances, such as conflict and government issues, participants, including two women, displayed unwavering dedication.

Multiply School aims to be the premier incubator for Christian leaders in the Caribbean, focusing on developing servant leaders in sports and beyond. They seek support for their \$40,000 budget to sustain and expand their transformative work in the region, welcoming both full and partial funding contributions.

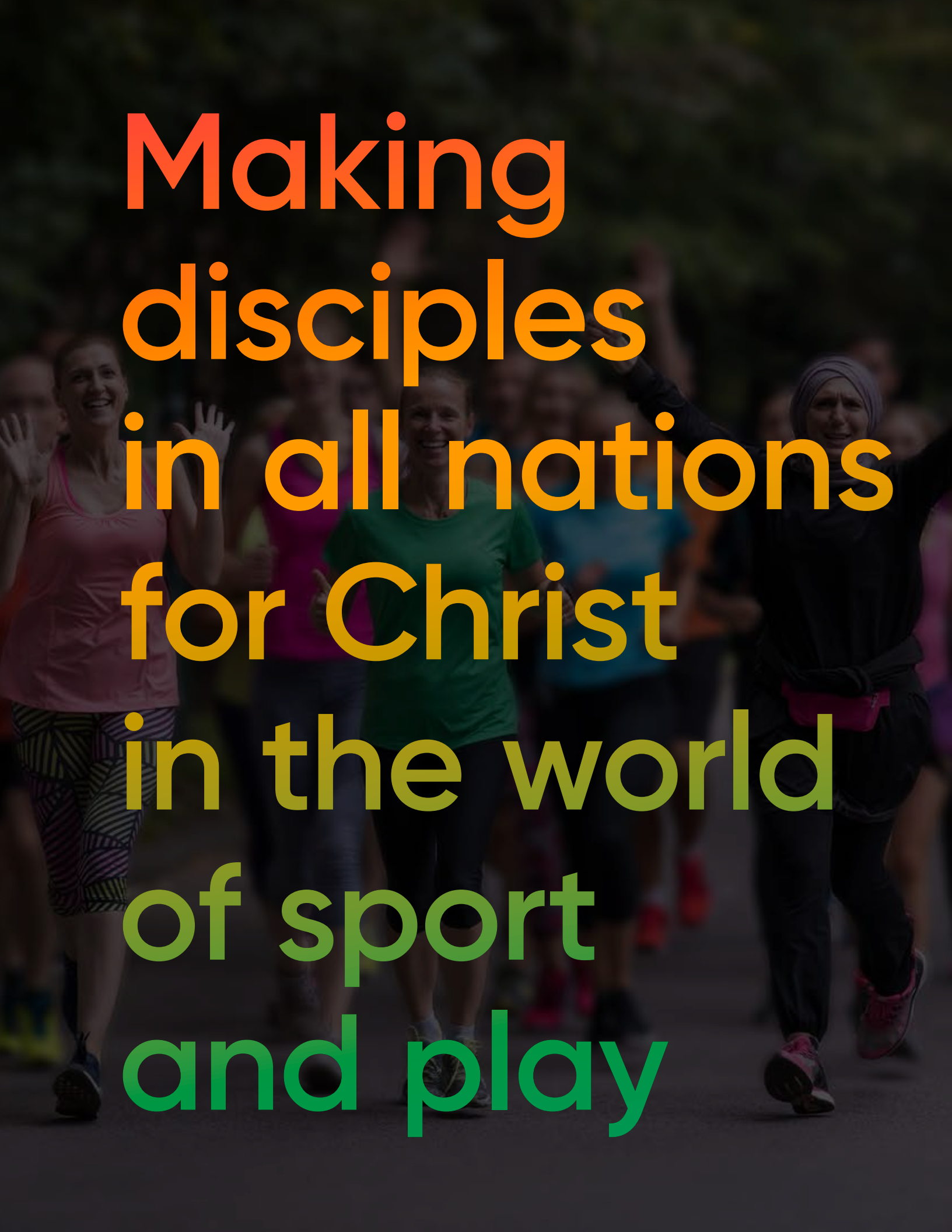
