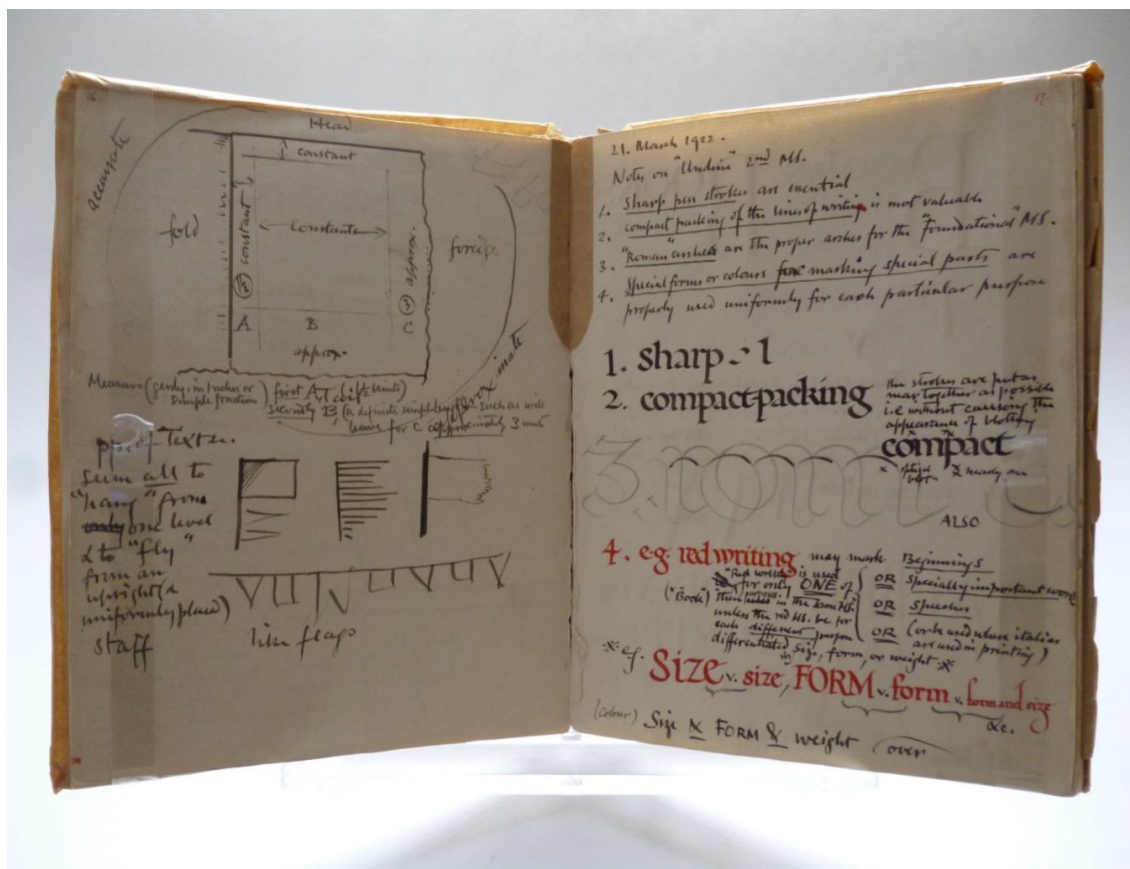


Edward Johnston, Majorie Bourne
Marjorie Bourne's calligraphy teaching book, 1922



A teaching book that belonged to Marjorie Bourne, whom Johnston taught in Ditchling. Marjorie was one of Johnston's few private paying pupils. She was also the sister of Joanna and Hilary Bourne, the founders of the museum. Alongside Johnston's examples and instructions are Marjorie's own attempts at calligraphy.
