


NANNY 'N ME Baby Thinking Development


NUMBERS! 1 2 3....

You can start to expose your baby to the idea of numbers by counting things wherever you can! We know that babies are interested in numbers based on research where very young babies were shown a box with 3 dolls in it. The box was then covered up and the number of dolls was changed. When the box was opened up again, babies looked for longer when the number of dolls had been changed, but if the number of dolls was the same, they didn't look/examine it for long.

THEME FOR THE WEEK

Having a theme for the week allows your little one to start to learn concepts such as colour and language. By repeating similar songs, words and books your little one's learning will be stimulated. This week, instead of a specific sea animal our theme is sea scenes.





SONG OF THE WEEK


I'm a little dolphin, I can swim Here is my tail, here is my fin. When I want to have fun with my friends, I wiggle my tail and dive right in!
