Main Painting Tools

Basic supply kit - <http://bit.ly/KIT-PYP-basic>
Upgraded Kit - <http://bit.ly/KIT-PYP-upgraded>

Tools: A device or implement, especially one held in the hand, used to carry out a particular function. The more you use them the more comfortable you get with them.
Practice, practice, practice

Brushes: Acrylic Brushes

Rounds (pointy) #2 & #4
Flat/bright (sq. top) #4 & #6
Angle #4 (optional)
Rigger #2 (optional)



Paint: Acrylic Paint

Student Grade Paint: is less expensive and thinner (more transparent) than artist grade paint. May require multiple coat for opaque coverage

Recommend: Liquitex basics for student grade paint



Artist Grade Paint: Is more expensive, more opaque and nice butter consistency to work with.

Recommended: Liquitex or Golden brand

*move up to artist grade paints 1 color at a time



Surfaces:

Canvas panel: thin panel covered with canvas, great for small pieces & fits in standard frames



Stretched canvas: canvas stretched tight around a wood frame. Tip: paint the edges for a finished look
