Business Plan

Strategic Plan

A *Strategic Plan* is primarily used for implementing and managing the *strategic* direction of an existing organization. ("What is the Difference Between a Business Plan and a Strategic Plan?", 2019)

Executive Summary

The executive summary describes what you do within your business, the problem you solve, your target population, and highlights major financial points.

Vision

The vision is a brief description of what the business is working to accomplish with the strategic plan. Characteristics every vision is it must be specific, be measurable, and have a realistic time frame.

Needs Analysis

A Needs Analysis is performed to find out if the vision and direction of the company are needed for the population being targeted.
