Informal Assessments

Overview: The Word Lists can be used for three different purposes. They can be used to:

1. Place students into the curriculum
2. Fast track students through the curriculum
3. Monitor student progress throughout the curriculum

Option 1: Guidance for Placement into the Curriculum

Score	Descriptor	Recommendation
5 correct	Too Easy	Give student the next test
3-4 correct	Just Right	Begin student here
0-2 correct	Too Hard	Give student the previous test

Option 2: Guidance for Fast Tracking Students through the Curriculum

Score	Descriptor	Recommendation
5 correct	Mastery	Give student the next test
3-4 correct	Partial	Start next set of lessons
0-2 correct	Weak	Consider repeating 3-5 previous lessons

Option 3: Guidance for Progress Monitoring

Score	Descriptor	Recommendation
4-5 correct	Mastery	Move on to the next lesson
2-3 correct	Partial	Consider repeating the previous 3-5 lessons
0-1 correct	Weak	Consider repeating the previous 8-10 lessons
