## **Complete the Challenge**


Using the provided leaf from Backroads by Angie Briggs, follow the instructions for stamping and coloring to create something similar to this image below.

NOTE: As stated in the Section 1, Lesson 1 manual, when adding elements to your document, do not fit them to the edges of the document as you would a photo.




## Things to make a note of:

• Notice how the boundaries of the element were broken up by masking them away. This creates a more unfinished, artistic look.



• Notice how only parts of the entire document were colored back in, specifically areas of the veins of the leaf.



- Do not move on to part 2 of this challenge until you've completed part 1.
- Try placing your stamped and colored image on a 7x5 greeting card.
- Consider using the paper and word art in the class downloads to finish things off.
