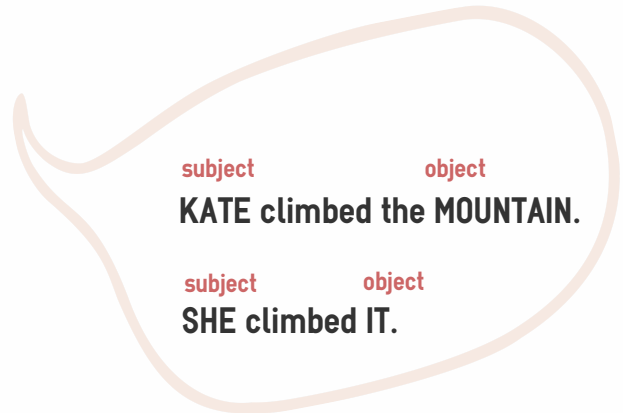

subject pronouns

reflexive/intensive pronouns

MYSELF
YOURSELF / YOURSELVES
HIMSELF
HERSELF
ITSELF
OURSELVES
THEMSELVES

"I did it myself".

adds emphasis - we don't need the intensive pronoun for the sentence to make sense.

"She hurt herself".

SHE and HERSELF are the same person - we need the reflexive pronoun for the sentence to make sense.

"This pen is MINE. YOURS is over there."

DEMONSTRATIVE PRONOUNS

this (singular)
that (singular)

these (plural)
those (plural)

"Look at this!" "Could I borrow these?"
Something close to where you are.

"Look at that!" "Could I borrow those?"
Something further away from where you are.
