ex. Loss of relationship, death, abuse, rejection of some sort, unfulfilled promise, experience with a person, lack of trust about certain things in your life (name the areas), unfulfilled expectation, family situations,

 (This is identifying the root (experience), not the false beliefs associated to the root)
