PHYSICAL SECURITY ASSESSMENT: DEFINITION & PURPOSE

 A critical, on-site examination of your house of worship to ascertain the present security status, identify deficiencies or excesses, determine the protection needed, and make recommendations to improve the overall security of the operation.





PHYSICAL SECURITY ASSESSMENT: DEFINITION & PURPOSE

- Provides the foundation for protecting your house of worship.
- Identifies:
 - What needs protection
 - What you're protecting the church from
 - What system weaknesses exist
 - What needs to be done
