- Titanium White

Paint Brushes:

- 1/2" Mop Brush
- #4 Titanium Robert Simmons

Canvas/Panel

- Ampersand Gessobord

Medium and Brush Cleaner:

- Gamblin Gamsol Odorless Mineral Spirit
- Gamblin Galkyd Fast Drying Medium
