Collage Sketchbook on-line class is designed to zero in on the basic elements and principles of design. Guiding and helping you become more aware of how to use the design skills, especially if you hit some rough patches as you problem solve your way through the creative process of Art. All assignments will be done in a sketchbook format using simple art materials, glue stick, paint, brushes, scissors and magazines. Each week you will be given examples, instruction and assignments. You can share your images on the Facebook Group-Abstract Mixed Media Collage. The object is to keep it very simple and not over complicated so you can see each element and principle separately. We will complete the class with a simple compositional assignment.

These images are samples of what we will work into and much more.

- Drawing paper, small pad (the drawing paper will be used to make solid colored paper for compositional assignment)
- Sketchbook (I like the black cover spiral, size 6 x 6, nice and handy to carry around)
- Assortment of Magazines with nice large images (ex: National Geographic, Art News etc. note art magazine work great because of the wonderful colors from the art work, no worry about copyright we are just using them for exercises)
- A few glue sticks
- Scissors
- Roll of wax paper (optional deli sheet)
- A small supply of baby wipes or a moist cloth
- Acrylic paints, red, yellow, blue and black
- Paint brushes
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Small piece of fine sandpaper
- small sponge trim roller- (optional hardware stores carry these)
