### I. **DEFINITION**:

- A. GREEK ADMIRAL
- B. ROMAN GENERAL/GOVERNOR
  - 1. <u>Conquer</u> new territory for the King.
  - 2. <u>Rule</u> it on behalf of the King.
  - 3. <u>Make</u> it Roman like the King.
  - 4. <u>Bring</u> it into the Empire.
- C. MODEL ALEXANDER THE GREAT (MACEDONIA)
  - 1. Conquered
  - 2. Created an *Ekklesia*
  - 3. Goal:
    - Govern for Macedonia.
    - Teach *koine* Greek <u>Speak</u>.
    - Establish Greek <u>Values</u> and <u>Culture</u>.
    - Bring it into the <u>Kingdom</u>.

## D. JESUS HIMSELF TOOK OVER THIS SECULAR/MILITARY WORD AND IDEA AND "CHRISTIANIZED" THEM.

#### 1. KEYS: MATTHEW 10:1-2A, 5

- Disciples *mathetes* <u>disciplined</u>
- Power *exousia* authority
- Commanded *diatasso* set in order (See Matthew 11:1)
- 2. Matthew 28:18-20 "Great Commission"

- Power *exousia* <u>authority</u>
- Go

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> "And when He had called His twelve disciples to *Him*, He gave them power *over* unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. Now the names of the twelve apostles are these:"

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying: "Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans"

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

# II. WHAT IS HIS RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER 5-FOLD MINISTRIES?

A. I CORINTHIANS 12:28 — THE GOVERNMENT PASSAGE ON 5-FOLD (CF. EPHESIANS 4:11)

"And God has set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues." (KJV)

- 1. Church *ekklesia*
- 2. Set *tithemi* incontrovertible
- 3. First *protos* foundation
- 4. Secondarily  $deuteros \underline{set}$  (on apostle)
  - Note: Adverb modifies <u>set</u>, not prophet.
- 5. Thirdly *tritos* <u>set on apostle</u> and <u>prophet</u>
  - Anointings are of <u>equal</u> value; <u>placement</u> is subordinated. e.g.
     Trinity


#### B. EPHESIANS 4:11
